Wage rate: \$15.58 per hour; Overtime: \$23.37 per hour

(Special wage rate: Work to be performed on DPRI-funded projects will be paid no less than \$15.58 per hour/\$23.37 overtime rate, and will be paid more where special Davis-Bacon Act rates apply.)

Duties: Constructs, erects, installs and repairs structures and fixtures using such materials as wood, wallboard, plastic, fiberglass or drywall. Reads blueprints, sketches, or building plans to determine type of work required, layout and materials needed. Erects framework for structure and lays subfloor board. Erects scaffolding or ladders for assembling structures. Performs work with prefabricated buildings. Builds and/or installs partitions, doors, framework, stairs, mantles, cabinets, or other wooden fixtures. Installs structures or fixtures, such as windows, frames, floorings, trim, and hardware. Replaces panes of glass, ceiling tiles, and doors. Constructs forms or chutes for pouring concrete. Uses levels, rules, plumb bobs, framing squares, and surveying equipment to ensure everything is level and secure. Works on top of stilts, ladders, and the top beams of buildings. Finishes surfaces of woodwork or wallboard in houses or buildings.

Benefits: Round-trip airfare for off-island hire; Food and lodging provided @ \$80.00 per week; local transportation from employer's designated lodging facility to/from jobsite; and employer provided health and medical insurance.
